- Site-specific
- Based on defined and measurable outcomes
- Risk-based
- Legally defensible
- Employer-mandated

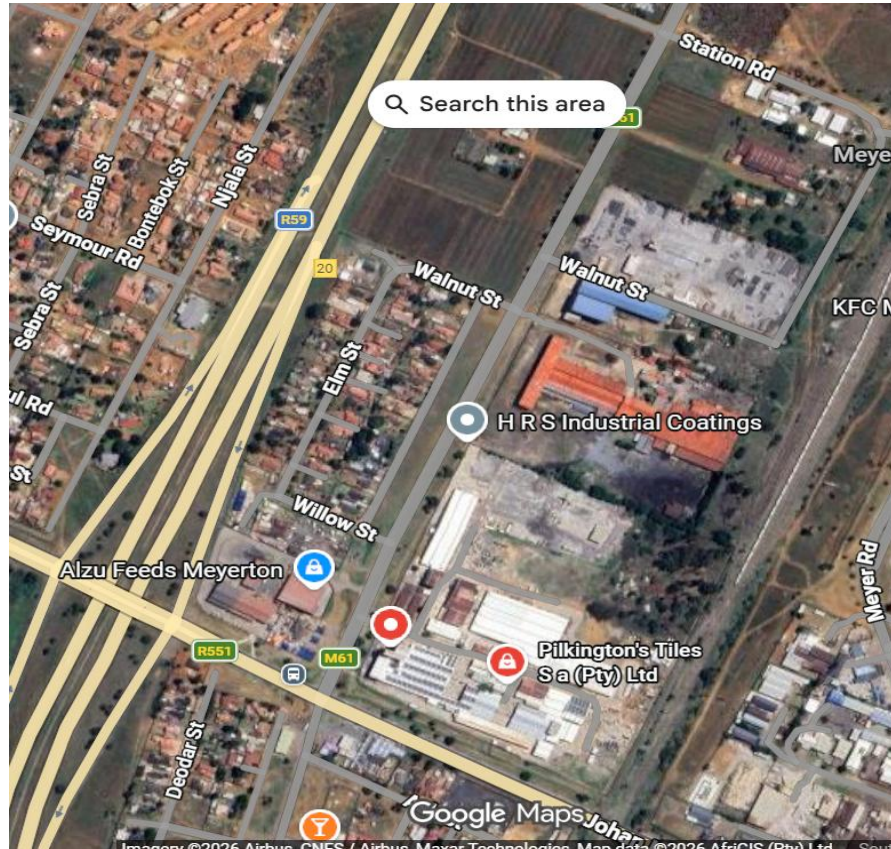
